The candidate can either attach to the application a pdf copy or refer to an open access repository.
<p>RESEARCH PROJECT</p>	<p>The research project (between 8.000 and 12.000 characters, without spaces), drafted in Italian, English or French, shall fit within one of the curricula (that must be identified in the application), specify the object of the research, clarify to what extent it can be considered original, shortly describe the state of the art in the field (with proper bibliographical references) and identify the research lines that the candidate thinks can be usefully pursued along the three years of the doctoral course.</p> <p>The candidate can either submit the same research project for the standard positions and for the positions with specific research topics or submit several separate projects. The application must, however, clearly specify to which position refers each project.</p>
<p>INTERVIEW MODE</p>	<p>In person (In the application form candidates residing abroad may ask to conduct the interview remotely)</p> <p>The interview can be conducted either in English or in Italian language</p>
<p>FURTHER INFORMATION ON THE INTERVIEW</p>	<p>During the interview the knowledge of a foreign language chosen by the candidate between English, French, German and Spanish will be assessed. Beyond the presentation of the research project, the interview can also include a short discussion on topics that can be deemed relevant for the curriculum or</p>

The assessment of the research project will be based mainly on its originality and methodological soundness.</p> <p>The interview will be assessed on the basis of the capacity to effectively present the research project, and to provide evidence of the knowledge of the related topics.</p>
